SUBJECT: Oil Field Cleanup Program Quarterly Status Report, Fiscal Year 2020, 2nd Quarter


Well Plugging: The 2nd quarter performance for State-Managed Plugging includes 277 wells plugged with a total expenditure of \$6,852,065.40 using Oil and Gas Regulation and Cleanup (OGRC) and Economic Stabilization funds. This includes wells that have been physically plugged, invoiced by the plugging contractor, and approved for payment by Field Operations. Additionally, during the 2nd quarter, 238 wells were approved for plugging with State funds. A total of 722 wells were physically plugged through the end of the 2nd quarter, of which, 587 have been invoiced and paid. The actual wells plugged and expenditure by district for fiscal years 2018, 2019 and 2020 and the well plugging goals and budgets by district for fiscal year 2020 are shown on the attached graphs. The fiscal year 2020 budget is \$42,281,610.

Site Remediation: The 2nd quarter performance for Site Remediation includes 96 cleanup activities completed with a total expenditure of \$1,228,911.16 using OGRC funds. Additionally, two activities were completed with a total expenditure of \$31,133.69 with the use of Grant Funds. During the 2nd quarter 42 cleanup activities were authorized for cleanup with State funds. Site Remediation has completed and formally closed a total of 133 cleanup activities using OGRC funds and two activities with Grant Funds for a total of 135 completed activities during fiscal year 2020. The actual remediation activities and expenditure by district for fiscal years 2018, 2019, and 2020 and the goals for the Site Remediation activities by district for fiscal year 2020 are shown on the attached graphs. The fiscal year 2020 budget is \$17,150,000.00.




